- PROMYS Europe seeks to encourage depth of understanding and mathematical habits of mind that support independence and creativity in exploring unfamiliar mathematical challenges.
- The programme builds a richly collaborative community of 24 pre-university students, 6 undergraduate counsellors, faculty, research mentors, and visiting mathematicians.
- Students receive daily feedback from their counsellors on their Number Theory problem sets.
- Advanced seminars, exploration labs, research projects, lectures, and minicourses offered on a wide range of mathematical topics. Guest lectures by eminent mathematicians.

PROMYS Europe at the University of Oxford is closely modelled on the 27-year-old PROMYS programme at Boston University.
