The 14th International Functional Analysis Award 2024

To encourage scholars to publish valuable articles, we annually confer awards to a maximum of two current students or graduates from the past four years of doctoral programs in <u>Armenia, Iran, Turkey, and Uzbekistan</u>. These awards are granted to individuals who have authored excellent scientificresearch articles in the field of mathematical analysis, encompassing functional analysis, operator theory, harmonic analysis, complex analysis, real analysis, matrix analysis, and so on.

The selection of awardee(s) is contingent upon the quality of a principal research article and the presentation of up to four additional selected articles from each candidate (for accepted articles we need the acceptance letters). The determination is made by a panel of international judges. The award comprises a certificate and a EURO 200 equivalent book voucher from the Birkhäuser publishing house.

We invite applications from any interested individual, who is <u>either a</u> <u>current doctoral student or has obtained a Ph.D. degree after January 1, 2020</u>, in the field of mathematical analysis. To apply, please include the following materials:

- 1. The PDF file of one principal published or accepted research article.
- 2. A list of up to 4 research articles that have been published or accepted (but please refrain from sending the article files themselves).
- **3.** The name of the supervisor along with his/her academic email.
